We would like to welcome your child to our fourth grade class for the 2020 school year at Cornelia F. Bradford School, PS#16. The following is a list of supplies your child will need. **Please label each item with your child's name and Room Number**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 notebooks • 3 pocket folders • 1 pack of wide-ruled lined paper • 1 pack of white copy paper • #2 Pencils (at least 10) • Erasers • Sharpener • Pencil case/storage box (not too big) -- storage space is VERY limited • Erasable pens (black or blue ink only) • Disinfectant spray (cleaner) • Small basket to keep items in (large enough to hold their books) *in an effort to keep children from touching each others items we ask each child to have their own "cubby" to be placed under their seats and carried with them from class to class to avoid contact 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 highlighters (different colors) • 4-pack dry-erase markers (black) • Dry eraser • Tissue box • Paper towels • Disinfectant wipes • Hand sanitizer • Post-Its "sticky notes" • 1 box Ziploc bags ("sandwich" size) • 1 box Ziploc bags ("storage" size) • Reusable/unbreakable water bottle • Personal headphones/earbuds - <u>to be the responsibility of your child - kept in the lockable lockers</u> • <u>Face mask, plus an extra in case something happens to first one</u> • <u>Hand soap - each child should have their own for trips to the bathroom - it will be stored in a ziplock bag in their cubbies (small bottles only)</u>
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Students will receive a homework planner (Agenda) in September and will be given time to copy all of their homework assignments each day.

Also, your child should read DAILY for 20-30 minutes to strengthen his/her reading stamina and comprehension. Children will begin multiplication facts almost immediately in September. Please have your child begin to memorize facts 1-12 during the summer.
