



Dear Parents and Guardians

Please find attached the schedule and class descriptions for our Fall Enrichment Program. We will be running classes in both the Annex and the Main building. Classes are based on grade level. All K and 1st grade students are invited to participate in classes held in the Annex. Students in grades 2 through 5 are invited to participate in classes held in the Main Building.

CASPER students will be able to attend classes in their building just as non casper students do. Non-Casper students who sign up for 3pm classes will be kept safe with a staff member at dismissal time and brought to their Enrichment class. Parents should not collect their child at 2:45pm. Parent will arrive when the class ends at 3:45 and the child will be dismissed to you.

Each class that you register your child for will incur a "CPA Fee". This fee is to cover the costs incurred to run our program - Insurance, Accounting, Website hosting, Paypal charges, Facilitators, and the Security fee that is charged by the District to be able to use the school buildings. For our Fall Enrichment Program we have reduced this fee from \$100 to \$50. We hope that this will cover all our costs and we will then be able to keep this reduced fee for the Spring Program too.

You will be able to register for classes on our website www.ps16cpa.net. Please know that our website has crashed every single time we have held Enrichment registration. We have proactively contacted our server and did all the recommended increases. If the site does crash please be patient - we will fix it! In an effort to hopefully reduce traffic a little we will stagger registration times as follows:
